



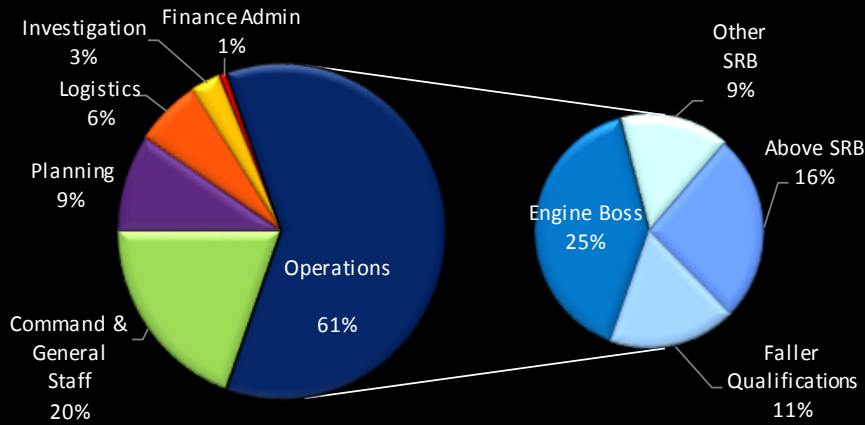

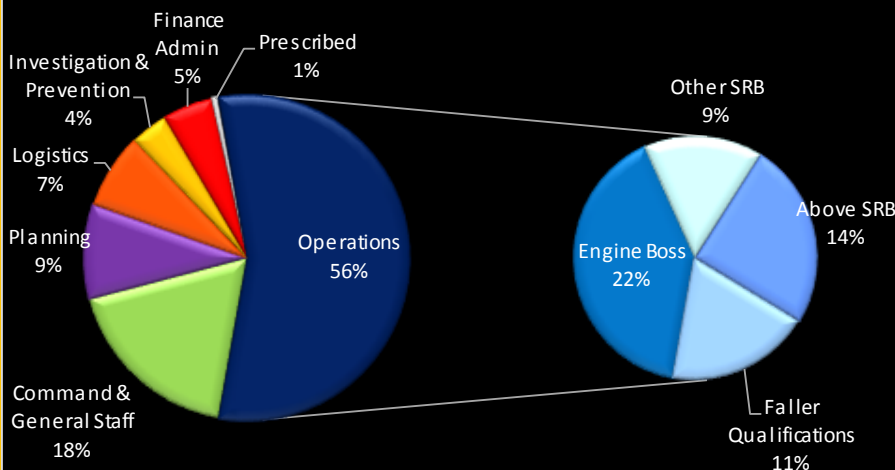

Accomplishments

- Manage ROSS Registration for 2,840 personnel with wildland qualifications; 4% increase over 2015.
- Maintain 678 Training and Experience Records in IQS; 8% increase over 2015.
- Issue Incident Qualification Cards for 678 Wildland Personnel; 8% increase over 2015.
- Prepared 411 Requests for the Qualification Committee to Review; 35% increase over last year.
- Updated, Verified and Organized the Arizona Priority Training Program for Dispatch to Implement. The number of participants increased 3% over 2015; Building critical wildland positions for Arizona.
- Drafted Arizona DFFM Minimum Experience Guidelines for All-Hazards Qualifications (SOG 708).
- Completed 4 IQS Courses, training 38 People from 28 Agencies, to manage IQS accounts for their own agencies. Accurate information in ROSS equals faster resource deployment.
